

ACMA (Decision maker)

- Regulates radio frequency spectrum to maximise public benefit
- Makes final decision on licence applications
- Required to take all relevant information into account

Proponent (Interested Party)

- Provides detailed information on proposed activities
- Works with MRO entity to seek solutions for reducing interference level to acceptable level
- Submits licence application to ACMA

MRO entity (Interested Party)

- Determines if interference would be acceptable to radio astronomy
- Works with proponent to seek solutions for reducing interference to acceptable levels
- Advises the ACMA on licence application on behalf of radio astronomy parties

State and Commonwealth Governments

- Encourage and facilitate ongoing cooperation between interested parties
- May provide policy advice to the AMCA if required

Interested parties encouraged to collaborate to seek mutually acceptable solution prior to licence application
